

Dear RTA participant,

You will find the new reporting categories below. You will need this new reporting format from 1 April 2019 onwards for your quarterly reports starting from the first quarter of 2019.

We have previously informed you about this in our [Annual report 'From targets to results, together'](#) from 20 December 2018, and in our [Newsletter 'Change in electrical and electronic equipment categories'](#) from March 2019. You can also find this newsletter in the annex.

### Reporting categories in force from the first quarter of 2019

#### **1. Temperature exchange equipment**

- A. Temperature exchange equipment (household/dual-use)
- B. Temperature exchange equipment (professional<sup>1</sup>)

#### **2. Screens, monitors and equipment (including screens with a surface of > 100 cm<sup>2</sup>)**

- A. Cathode ray tubes (household/dual-use)
- B. Flat-panels (household/dual-use)
- C. Laptops, tablets, and navigation equipment<sup>2</sup> (household/dual-use)
- D. Screens, monitors and equipment with screens (professional<sup>1</sup>)

#### **3. Lights (through [Stichting Lightrec](#))**

- A. LED light bulbs
- B. Fluorescent tubes, energy-saving light bulbs and discharge lamps

#### **4. Large equipment (exterior dimensions > 50 cm)\***

- A. Large equipment (> 50 cm | household/dual-use | excl. solar panels, electric bikes)
- B. Large equipment (> 50 cm | professional<sup>1</sup> | excl. solar panels, electric bikes)
- C. Solar panels<sup>3</sup>
- D. Electric bikes<sup>2</sup>

#### **5. Small equipment (without exterior dimensions > 50 cm)\*\***

- A. Small equipment (≤ 50 cm | household/dual-use)
- B. Small equipment (≤ 50 cm | professional<sup>1</sup>)

#### **6 Small IT and telecommunications equipment (without exterior dimensions > 50 cm)**

- A. IT and telecom equipment (≤ 50 cm | household/dual-use)
- B. IT and telecom equipment (≤ 50 cm | professional<sup>1</sup>)

*\* No equipment which falls under categories 1 to 3 belongs to this category.*

*\*\* No equipment which falls under categories 1 to 3 and 6 belongs to this category.*

*<sup>1</sup> The distinction between household/dual-use and professional applies to reporting the 'Put on Market'. For processing, this distinction can hardly (if at all) be made, so everything can be reported under household/dual-use. If it is difficult to make a distinction for the 'Put on Market', a substantiated estimate suffices.*

<sup>2</sup> For the reporting categories laptops, tablets, navigation equipment and electric bikes, a substantiated estimate (sample) suffices for the report of the processing.

<sup>3</sup> Solar panels with an exterior dimension of  $\leq 50$  cm may also be assigned to this category. The proportion of solar panels with exterior dimensions of  $\leq 50$  cm is estimated to be less than 1%. This distribution will be mapped by using samples and will be reported separately.
